This full stack application allows users to search for books in the Google Books API, read and review books, and keep track of their reading. This application was developed using TypeScript, Node.js, Express and React.

Kid Invest

Earnings may also be invested in kid-friendly companies created using a real-time stock market API where the businesses simulate actual stock fluctuations. This application incorporated Spring Boot, Stock API, and MySQL.
