Shearup

Shearup is a full-stack application created using Java, Spring Boot, Thymeleaf, JavaScript, CSS, MySQL, Bootstrap, and HTML. A web application created remotely during COVID, where barbers and clients can register and come together. The Barber profile displays available hours, location via Mapbox API, and the ability to add and edit services. Clients can request to book with barbers, view profiles, and leave reviews of barber's services. The Profile and pictures of services uploaded via the Filestack API. Our team worked together to deploy this web application at shear-up.com.
