Using API's I am able to showcase their music via Spotify and allow the client authorization to upload images to a database and display them on their art page. I work with the client's wireframes and designs to implement them on their site.

E-Yearbook Online

A full-stack web application that implemented SpringBoot Framework, Thymeleaf, Html, CSS, MySQL, JavaScript, and Java EE that allowed a parent to register a child on a site to view their school's yearbook. Once registered, the student has access to a site dedicated to electronically signing yearbook on a student's profile, flip through the yearbook, search for students, and print a pdf version of their comments. Parents are also given access to monitor the content posted by their children and on their child's page.
